1. Amenity Suspension Hearing

Ms. Sandy walked through the rules violated, the notice provided, and read the resident's statement to the Board.

On a motion by Mr. Koford, seconded by Mr. Leonard, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors agreed to not suspend Mr. Hickey's amenity privileges at this time, but that future incidents would result in a 90-day suspension after a verbal warning and a permanent suspension on the third occurrence, for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

Ms. Sandy discussed with the Board the regulations surrounding holding a summer day camp at the District's amenity facilities, as well as District Counsel's recommended best practices. At this time the Board decided not to move forward with granting use of the amenity facility for a summer day camp.

B. District Engineer

On a motion by Mr. Koford, seconded by Mr. Pellan, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors accepted the resignation of District Engineer Heidt Design for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

On a motion by Mr. Koford, seconded by Mr. Pellan, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the RFQ process, and directed District staff to advertise for the same, for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

C. Clubhouse Manager

Mr. Lawrence presented the clubhouse management report and answered general questions from the Board. Mr. Lawrence commented on needing a breakdown of his and Mark's hours and if they are interchangeable. Mr. Lawrence commented on the excessive number of sheriffs' visits the District is having and the fact that they will start charging the District for these.
