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THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Staff Reports - Part I

A. Field Manager

Mr. Radcliff presented the latest field inspection report to the Board for review. The Board discussed the timing of shutting off the irrigation to coincide with the District Engineer's need to research.

i. Consideration of Landscaping Proposals

Mr. Radcliff presented three landscaping proposals to the Board for consideration. Discussion ensued. The Board approved the first proposal, for installation of fall flowers but using perennials in place of annuals; tabled the second proposal, for mulch installation, pending receipt of additional proposal for consideration; and chose not to approve the third proposal, for pine straw installation.

On a motion by Mr. Pellan, seconded by Mr. Kimpland, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the installation of perennials by Yellowstone for an amount not to exceed \$9,000.00 and authorized the Chair to finalize the selection of the type of perennials for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.
