Pond and Lake Management: The recent rain events have increased the water levels in most of the ponds which is assisting in combating the subsurface and surface algae. Considering the hot humid season, the ponds are in great condition. We will need to keep a watchful eye on any algae outbreaks as this is the prime season for outbreaks.



Landscape Maintenance



Enhancement Plan: The new vegetation is beginning to rebound with visible signs of new growth throughout the community. Recommend continual monitoring.

Hedges / Shrubs: Most of the hedges and shrubs are healthy and pruned well; however, some of the new shrubs are struggling. The irrigation lines may need to be replaced, as it appears that the shrubs are lacking irrigation.





Mowing: The turf in most areas appears to be healthy; however, the heat is taking a toll on areas that lack irrigation and shade. The mowing schedule also appears to be off as not all sections were mowed on the same week.





Bed Maintenance: Most beds look good; however, there are pockets of the community where the beds are being taken over by weeds and runners. The chemically treated weeds should be removed once they are brown. Removal will add value to the overall appearance.

Observations & Recommendations





Magnolia Sprout: Recommend replanting the Magnolia sprout in a bed that would benefit from a new addition.

Palm Trees (Beautyberry): The Palm trees on Beautyberry were missed. These trees were top priority to trim. Recommend scheduling the trimming when staff can be present to ensure they are not missed.







Runners: The Foxtail pool beds require weed treatment on both sides of the bed, especially on the backside of the hedge.

Irrigation Box Lids: Replace three irrigation box lids in the Foxtail Amenity Center side yard.

Foxtail Common Area Hedge: Remove the decling shrubs and replace as soon as possible. Check irrigation.

Enhancement Plan: The newley replaced plants are thriving, despite the high temperatures.

*All of these observations were reported to RedTree.

District Manager Report

June Highlights

Big Lake Water Runoff: Board Liaison Darrell Thompson requested proposals from several contractors.

Complaints: Staff has received several complaints about the condition of the poolside furniture and lack of cleanliness in the restrooms. Assessments of the restrooms indicate high summer usage and wet floors due to the tracking in of pool water.

Drainage Concern: Staff was notified of standing water near the utility building concrete slab; however, the water percolated at a normal rate, but staff will keep a watchful eye on the area.

Fountains: Blue Water Aquatics is scheduled to repair the fountains that are offline

Foxtail Parking Enforcement: The parking decals were on backorder with no date of delivery. The original order was canceled. A second vendor was contacted, and we anticipate taking delivery in 10 days.

Pool Resurfacing: Cooper Pools will be submitting a recommendation / proposal for resurfacing the big pool as the Board requested.

Pool Services: Pool Troopers assessed the pools to provide a service proposal for the Board's consideration.

Poolside Furniture: Additional poolside furniture was purchased for both pool decks.

Golf Cart Replacement: An estimated delivery date was given at the time of the order; however, they anticipate a time frame of October and / or November.

Signage Project: Architectural Signage & Printing submitted a proposal for the Board's review, along with the Romaner Graphics proposal.

Utility Shed: Tuff Shed is currently waiting on the delivery of the door.

The four foot level bubble confirms **the** sidewalk at this location does slope towards the homeowner side.



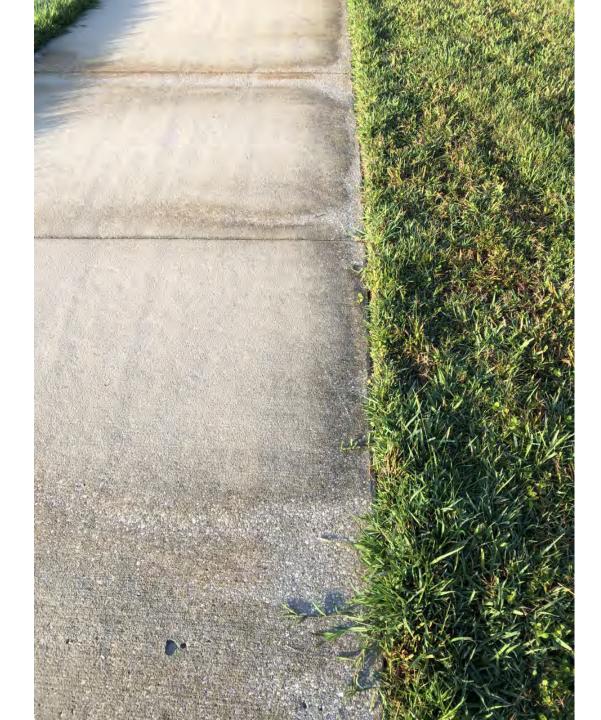
